Everyday **before you leave the house** make sure of having the following:

1. Your official **Identification Card (ID)** with your picture
2. Your **Statement of Entry**
3. Your **pen, pencil, eraser** etc. should be in a **transparent plastic bag** ([there will be no stationary available to be provided by the British Council](#))
4. Your **calculator** should be according to the boards' standards. Please refer to Use of calculators document- **updated**.

(Unfortunately you will not be able to sit for the exam if you don't have your ID and your Statement of Entry)

*** You should be at the exam venue 1 hour prior to the start of the exam scheduled time as you will need to proceed to the exam room 45 minutes prior the start time.**

*****Exams marked in red in which candidates to stay in the examinations room under full supervision till Cambridge Key Time passes for am and pm sessions.**

2. You should come in your school uniform.
